

Admission Procedure & Eligibility

B.Pharm & D.Pharm – Chhattisgarh State

Eligibility Criteria

B.Pharm (Bachelor of Pharmacy)

- Passed 10+2 (Science) with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects.
- Mathematics or Biology as one of the optional subjects.
- Minimum marks: 45% for General category and 40% for SC/ST/OBC as per state norms.
- Candidates must fulfill Chhattisgarh domicile or state eligibility rules.

D.Pharm (Diploma in Pharmacy)

- Passed 10+2 (Science) with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects.
- Mathematics or Biology as one of the optional subjects.
- Minimum marks: 45% for General category and 40% for Reserved category.
- Age and eligibility criteria as per PCI and State Government rules.

Admission Procedure (Chhattisgarh)

1. Candidates must appear in the **PPHT (Pre-Pharmacy Test)** conducted by **CG Vyapam**.
2. Based on PPHT merit, candidates participate in online counseling conducted by DTE Chhattisgarh.
3. Seat allotment is done according to merit, category, and availability of seats.
4. Candidates must report to the allotted college for document verification and fee submission.
5. Final admission is confirmed after university enrollment through the institution.

Required Documents

- 10th and 12th Mark Sheets
- Transfer Certificate (TC)
- Migration Certificate (if applicable)
- Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- Domicile Certificate
- Aadhaar Card
- Passport size photographs

Note: Admission is strictly governed by the norms of the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), CG Vyapam, and DTE Chhattisgarh. Any changes issued by the competent authorities shall be applicable.
